

UPCOMING COURSES IN SEPTEMBER AND OCTOBER 2014

ICE Professional Review Courses

The ICE Professional Review – Preparing for the Interview is a day long course running in Leeds on **10 September** for a maximum of 4 people. It is intended for those sitting their professional review in the autumn session and delegates need to submit their draft professional review reports in advance. On the day of the course, after an introductory session on the review process as a whole, each candidate will undertake a full length mock interview with an experienced ICE Reviewer. After the course delegates receive individual constructive feedback on their draft reports and interview. Guidance will be provided also on possible lines of questioning at review and the types of written exercise questions that may be set based on the submitted reports. The course costs £375 + VAT per person including all pre and post-course work by the tutor.

The ICE Professional Review – Overview and Preparation is a full day course running in Chesterfield on **29 October** at a cost of £220 + VAT. It is taught by an experienced ICE Reviewer and aimed at those preparing to sit their review in the next 12 months. After a reprise of the review process and the attributes which delegates will need to demonstrate to be successful, each of the component parts (the sponsors forms, the submission reports and CPD records, the presentation and interview, and the written exercise) will be examined to help delegates deepen their understanding of each and give them an appreciation of what the reviewers will be looking for.

CDM Courses

We are running two complimentary half day courses on the CDM Regulations which are aimed at recent graduates or those new to CDM. Our **CDM 2007 Regulations – An Overview** course provides delegates with an introduction to the regulations and how to work within them. Its sister course is **CDM Regulation 2007 - Managing Out Risk** focuses on designing out risk and looks at ways in which delegates can effectively use the regulations in practice. Both courses cost just £125 + VAT. The courses are running at East Midlands Airport on **8 & 22 September**, and are repeated in Leeds on **6 & 20 October**.

Geotechnics Courses

Our **Foundations and Building Settlement** course is aimed at civil and structural engineers looking to refresh and develop their theoretical and practical understanding of foundation design. It is running in Chesterfield on **15 September** and costs £220 + VAT. It covers how foundations are built and fail, and the fundamentals of bearing capacity and settlement for shallow foundations and piles, before focusing on design principles and practice. It includes too an introduction to EC7 design for foundations.

Our ever-popular course **Mentoring for Engineering Geologists on Geotechnical Engineering** is running once again in Chesterfield on **15 October**. Ideal for Engineering Geologists and Civil Engineers that do not specialise in this field, it aims to develop a core understanding of how soils behave in principle and to then apply this learning to the design of foundations, retaining walls and slopes. This intensive course provides the equivalent of 1.5 days training in a single 'long day' format to make it both cost and time effective. Numbers are limited to a maximum of 12 to ensure there is interactive learning and discussion with individual guidance. The course costs £320 + VAT.
